## Current Projects Status

### Street Trees are scheduled for pruning

- Protected area trees that are diseased, infested or dangerous to HOA properties are currently being scheduled for removal.
- Laurel Hedges have been cut to an acceptable height and shaped to allow appropriate regrowth .
- Blackberry vines have been cut back 10" around CHHOA parameter trail between Hilton Lake properties and Cascade Highlands property boundaries.
- Mulga Pine stumps are being removed as time and volunteers permit. Mulch has been purchased to cover these areas afterwards. One cul-de-sac has already been cleared and mulch applied.
